PROGRAM AREA: Public Works Department / Lands and Natural Resources Office

POSITION TITLE: Natural Resources Coordinator

REPORTING PROTOCOL: Reports directly to the Lands Manager

The Natural Resources Coordinator (NRC), with direction from the Lands Manager, will assist in managing, protecting, and enhancing the health of the environment on Wasauksing First Nation, contributing to the social, environmental, and economic well-being of the Wasauksing First Nation community. The NRC will provide professional and technical advice and recommendations on all aspects of resource management, identify and resolve a variety of environmental issues and threats, and coordinate the daily operations of the Beach Patrol Program, the Aquatic Monitoring Program, and additional initiatives arising from the approved Environmental Management Plan.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist and work with specialized professionals and the Lands Manager to develop, implement, and document natural resource management strategies;
- Develop and deliver environmental awareness initiatives;
- Assist the Lands Manager in establishing an Environmental Protection Regime;
- Conduct environmental impact assessments for proposed developments within Wasauksing First Nation territory;
- Prepare project proposals, carry out surveys and mapping, data collection, geographic information systems, and other field work as necessary;
- Oversee the daily operations of the Beach Patrol Program, including the hiring and the training of Beach Patrol Crew Members;
- Coordinate training opportunities and sampling work plans as directed by the Aquatic Monitoring Plan, and provide annual progress reports on the Aquatic Monitoring Program;
- Develop a Field Operations Safety Manual for all Lands and Natural Resources' staff;
- Work collaboratively with all Lands and Natural Resources' staff in reviewing compliance applications, conducting site inspections, and participating in consultations as needed;
- Comprehensive documentation and tracking of all incoming Areas of Concerns through the Aquatic Monitoring Program QuickCapture App, field observations, and contact information for external agencies; and
- Perform other duties, tasks, and responsibilities as required and as assigned.

SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Post-secondary degree/diploma in relevant field and 2-3 years relevant employment experience;
- Experience working with Indigenous Councils, other First Nations, and/or cultural organizations;
- Must have own vehicle and valid Class "G" driver's license; and
- Must provide current CPIC acceptable to position upon conditional offer.
